

Capo d'Istria Malvasia 2021

In the Debeli rtič vineyards of Slovenian Istria, handpicked Malvasia grapes undergo meticulous processing. This results in a deeply golden Malvasia with ripe yellow plum, star fruit, and almond aromas, a full-bodied flavor, balanced acidity, and a creamy finish, showcasing the region's terroir.

Wine description:

- Wine region: Slovenian Istria
- Vineyards: Debeli rtič
- Soil type: Eocene flysch with marl and sandstone
- Variety: Malvasia
- Harvest: Exclusively manual harvest in the first half of September
- **Processing:** Excellent ripe and healthy grapes were cold macerated for some time after stalking and fermented in 225 L barrique barrels after pressing and clarifying. The selected wood for barrique barrels is mainly oak of various origins and part of acacia wood. Here, the wine matured for 12 months, and further maturation took place in old 3,000 L oak barrels until bottling.
- Color: Intense golden-yellow color.
- Aroma: Accentuated aroma of ripe yellow plum, carambola and almond with notes of Mediterranean herbs, resin, acacia flowers, honey and a hint of vanilla.
- **Taste:** Extremely full, rich taste, which blends into a nice harmony with pleasant ripe acids. Extraordinary minerality and a long, slightly spicy and creamy aftertaste confirm the nobility of this wine.
- Alcohol: 13,5 vol. %
